

#### **OUR IMPACT**

We offer free dental and prenatal care, food, clothing and financial assistance to meet emergency needs, hot lunches 5 days a week at Neighborhood House and diverse educational opportunities such as afterschool care, money management, GED and ESL classes. We are dedicated to removing potential barriers for those in need in order to reach self-sufficiency. Every day our impact is felt when an individual makes a healthy choice, when a tutor inspires a child, when a healthy baby is born, when a student passes the GED exam, when a community member walks through our doors to donate and volunteer – and when an individual or family no longer needs our services. 6,862 people benefited from the support of OLMOCS' services and programs in 2019 — the most of any year in history to date.

Since 1989, Our Lady of Mercy Community Outreach Services, Inc. (OLMCOS) has been an anchor in the Sea Islands community of Johns, James and Wadmalaw Islands. We were founded just two weeks prior to the Hurricane Hugo devastation that hit Charleston, South Carolina, and immediately became dedicated to bringing disaster relief to our community. Neighborhood House has served the Eastside community of downtown Charleston for over 100 years. In 2005, OLMCOS integrated Neighborhood House into its service structure. Today, both locations provide basic needs, emergency services, along with health and wellness programs.
